

PCSW Child Care Survey Pilot

Brief description of project:

The purpose of this pilot was to have various constituents in the University Community “take” the Child Care Needs Assessment Survey and provide feedback on question wording, content, etc.

Who was asked to complete survey:

An intentional sample to represent faculty, staff, and students from both Main Campus and Health Sciences Campus.

Response Rate: 66.7% (14 of 21)

Administration Type: StudentVoice e-mail

Summary of Key Findings and Actions Taken:

Feedback from the pilot respondents provided useful information for revisions on the final version of the Child Care Needs Assessment. These include

- Clarification on the age ranges
- For people who are uncertain about their future child plans, changing the wording of the question and/or the response options to reflect this uncertainty
- Further distinction between “census” (what children do you have) and child care needs
