Ally Awareness Week 2011 Evaluation

Brief description of program: The programs this week addressed topical issues aimed at raising awareness of allies including a film, a speaker's panel, a safe zone training, a service project, a social including a presentation of "Ally of the Year" award, and culminating in the day of silence.

Who was asked to complete survey:

Students, faculty, staff, and community members who attended the film, the panel of ally speakers, or the day of silence.

Respondents 25 people

Administration Type: paper & pencil, and entered by office into StudentVoice

Summary of Key Findings: Responses were almost entirely positive and supportive with the largest percentage of respondents self-identifying as "ally." All responses came from the film and the panel, and none were recorded from the day of silence.
