

Orientation Survey - Spring 2013

Brief description of project:

Assesses learning as a result of and satisfaction with orientation program.

Who was asked to complete the survey:

First-Year and Transfer students who attended an orientation program for Spring 2013 matriculating students.

How many people were asked? 1,500

Respondents: 191

Administration Type: iPod Touch and web link

Summary of Key Findings:

- Many respondents did not feel the length of the program was necessary for their success
 - However, many respondents found the level of detail in presentations helpful
- Respondents wanted more engaging presentations and presentation formats
- Respondents wanted information about “practical” side of college – parking, student organizations, meeting other transfer students

Actions Taken:

- Reexamining length of program and differentiation of information presented to transfer students vs first-year students
