

Utah NASPA Conference Evaluation 2010

Brief description of project: Evaluation of statewide Utah NASPA Conference hosted on the University of Utah campus.

Who was asked to complete survey: All attendees.

Response Rate: 49.4% (130 of 263)

Administration Type: StudentVoice e-mail

Summary of Key Findings: The conference was the largest attended State NASPA conference. Overall, evaluations were highly positive. The morning keynote was well received, however the lunch keynote was less positively rated. The high quality of the food was commented on by several participants. Some of the lower ratings were associated with the facilities (excessive noise in some presentation rooms) and some specific programs.

Actions Taken: Reviewed by 2010 NASPA planning committee. Results provided to 2011 planning committee for use in planning the next conference, to be hosted by Westminster College.
