



2011 Edie Kochenour Memorial Lecture Evaluation

Brief description of program (if applicable):

Annual lecture in honor of Edie Kochenour. This year's lecture was entitled *Lessons Learned: Navigating the Leadership Path in Higher Education* and was delivered by *Mary Sue Coleman, President of the University of Michigan*

Who was asked to complete survey:

All registered participants, whether or not they attended the lecture. This included U staff (52% of respondents), faculty (32%), and graduate students (7%), as well as postdoctoral fellows (3.5%) and community attendees.

Summary of Key Findings:

121 individuals completed the online evaluation. Feedback was mostly positive regarding the lecture topic and event logistics.

Actions Taken:

The results of the online evaluation will be used to improve planning for next year's lecture and identify future lecture topics.

Which department and/or program goals does this survey align with?

The online evaluation was requested by Lauren Weitzman, chair of the 2011 Edie Kochenour Memorial Lecture Committee. The Edie Kochenour Memorial Lecture Committee is a free-standing committee that reports to the Edie Kochenour Memorial Fund Advisory Board.
