

Directors Retreat 2010

Brief description of project:

The Student Affairs Leadership Team (SALT) and Student Affairs Directors annually spend 1-2 days in a retreat that includes education on critical issues and an opportunity to plan collaborative efforts over the upcoming year. For the 2010 retreat the focus was on strategic planning in the context of national trends and trends/goals for the University of Utah. The purpose of this survey was to gauge the satisfaction with the retreat and to provide feedback that can be used for future retreats.

Response Rate: 66.7% (20 of 30)

Administration Type: StudentVoice e-mail

Summary of Key Findings:

Overall, the majority of attendees indicated that they were satisfied/very satisfied with each component of the program. Attendees indicated the highest level of satisfaction hearing from President Young and Paul Brinkman about current issues at the University of Utah. They also reported satisfaction with the meeting accommodations.
