

IJSHS Evaluation 2010

Brief description of program: 3 day event where high school students from 5 states come to the U to compete for scholarships for original research projects they've done.

Respondents: 167 students

Administration Type: paper

Summary of Key Findings:

- Nearly 60% responded that they would attend the 2011 event even if we raised the registration fee from \$50 to \$75 pp.
- New tours were introduced this year by the archaeology and anthropology centers, physics stellar imaging, and some more were added in the engineering field.
- We had 6 new schools attend this year making a total of 21 schools that participated.

Actions Taken: Some respondents said they would like to learn more about what the U has to offer overall, so we will be adding an information session to next year's agenda. An effort will be made to send information about this even to more schools within the 5 state region.
