

Osher Reentry Mid Year Survey 2011

Brief description of program:

The Bernard Osher Foundation was founded in 1977 by Bernard Osher, a successful businessman and community leader. The Foundation seeks to improve quality of life for residents all over the United States through post-secondary student scholarships and arts, cultural, and educational grants. The Osher Reentry Scholarship is targeted to non-traditional students between 25-50, who have had a five year break in their education.

Who was asked to complete survey:

All scholarship recipients were asked to complete the survey.

Response Rate: 67.9% (19 of 28)

Administration Type: StudentVoice e-mail

Summary of Key Findings:

We found that the current administration of the Osher Reentry Scholarship is satisfactory for most students. We also found that 42% of Osher Reentry scholars are transfer students.

Actions Taken:

The WRC will look at bringing in previous Osher Reentry Scholars as guest speakers. In general, the students are satisfied with the program.
